What is Cyber Essentials?

Cyber Essentials is a UK government backed scheme which is aimed at ensuring businesses are protected against cyber related attacks. By implementing the five key controls you are ensuring that cyber best practices are achieved, you are reducing the risk of attack from the most common cyber related threats and help demonstrate your commitment to cyber security.

Why do I need Cyber Essentials?

Achieving the Cyber Essentials certification will help your business protect itself against the increasing rise in cyber crime related attacks. By implementing the five key security controls you will help to reduce the overall threat upon your business, by ensuring that the most common threats are protected against.

If you are looking to work with the government or bid upon government tenders in the future, you will need to have Cyber Essentials in place before you can continue. Starting sooner rather than later will be a win-win.

How does it work?

The Cyber Essentials scheme is based upon a set of five security controls which, when correctly deployed, will provide you with a level of protection from the most common cyber security threats. These controls apply to a defined scope, which could be part or all of your company, depending upon your needs.

- ✓ Secure your devices and software
- ✓ Control access to your data and services
- ✓ Protect from viruses and other malware
- ✓ Keep your devices and software up to date

The five key controls

The foundations of the Cyber Essentials scheme is made up of five core security controls. By implementing these controls you are helping to protect your business and sensitive information. Not only does it help protect your business, but you can also demonstrate to your clients and suppliers that you take the threat of cyber related crime seriously and that you meet government approved cyber security standards.

The five controls are simple best practice recommendations that, if implemented, will reduce the chances of being at the reiving end of a cyber attack.

Malware Protection

Malware or malicious software, if infected can roam your network and impact your devices and damage your business reputation. Cyber Essentials looks to see what processes you have in place to identify and ensure that all devices connected to the internet are protected.

Secure Configuration

Most systems come with a default configuration which allows it to be as multi-functional as possible. However, this may not leave it secure. Cyber Essentials checks to see what controls are in place to ensure that devices on the network are protected against threats.

Patch Management

No matter what device you have, it will more than likely be out of date quickly due to manufactures releasing new fixes and functionality. The Cyber Essentials process checks to see if you are protecting your devices through patching/ updating often.

Boundary Firewalls

Boundary firewalls are devices which protect your own private network from the public internet. Firewalls are designed to protect you from threats and analyse the information which is sent through it. Cyber Essentials checks to ensure that you have one in place and its setup correctly.

Access Management

Having appropriate access control ensures that minimal damage will be done if an account is compromised. You should only grant accounts the minimum amount of permissions which are needed to perform the role and only provide them to who needs it.

Cyber Essentials Plus

Cyber Essentials Plus is the next level up in the Cyber Essentials process and it involves an on-site audit by an assessor. The assessor will check to make sure what you have said in the self assessment is correct and that you are carrying out the five controls.

The Cyber Essentials Plus certification involves performing a credentials vulnerability scan of your internal network, a scan of your external gateway as well as testing your controls for the receiving of email attachments as well as checking to see how you manage the downloading of different file types.
